Full of laughs and intrigue, 13 Rue de L'Amour is a wacky, door-slamming bedroom farce with a true lunatic spirit. A philandering husband, a wife set on revenge, a love-starved countess-concierge, befuddled policemen, a saucy maid, and other plotting parties find their way to the same address and frolic through a maze of mistaken identities and false arrests. Reminiscent of a good Marx Brothers movie, this comedy's illogical logic is sublimely ridiculous.

Olney Theatre Center for the Arts is located on Maryland Route 108 (Olney-Sandy Spring Road) in Olney, Maryland, one and one-half miles east of Georgia Avenue (Route 97) and two miles west of New Hampshire Avenue (Route 650). Parking is free.
